




AT BAMRS, doctors are encouraged to combine clinical work with academics and contribute to the medical knowledge present worldwide through published work in leading national and international journals.





2 Retinopathy Of Prematurity - ROP

Free screenings for underprivileged infants at Dr. Hedgewar Hospital have enabled early detection and treatment of ROP, a serious eye condition that can lead to blindness if untreated



A 30-week 1110 gm baby was diagnosed with Retinopathy of Prematurity for both eyes. Early diagnosis and procedural intervention saved the baby's vision.

A 9-year-old boy on maintenance hemodialysis overcame catheter-related bloodstream infection, PRES, and hypertension, requiring peritoneal dialysis. After his mother's successful kidney donation and transplant, his creatinine normalized, and post-transplant complications were managed. 3 months post-transplant, both are healthy, with no further dialysis required.

5 Department of Infectious Diseases at DHR

To bridge the gap in specialized care for highly infectious diseases across the entire Marathwada region, DHR has partnered with IDRF USA and Dinanath Mangeshkar Hospital, Pune to establish a dedicated Department of Infectious Diseases.
